
DID YOU KNOW?

There is a lot more than you might think that goes into all that East Lake UMC is and does. Check out this broad financial summary to learn more about what we do with our resources.

ESTIMATED ANNUAL EXPENSES

- Utilities/Insurance (\$133,000)
- Buildings/Grounds (\$37,000)
- Food/Ministry Supplies (\$11,449)
- Permits/Inspections (\$2,595)
- Office Expenses, etc. (\$6,655)
- District Giving (\$11,500)
- Pastor's Benefits (\$23,748)
- People/Payroll (\$189,919)



QUICK FACTS

We provide meeting space for 10 community organizations in our building.

East Lake is a food desert with no local grocery store, where 24% of people live below the poverty line, and 44% have a household income under \$25,000.

Our "Feeding Our Friends" mission fund has especially grown. We established it in January 2023 with \$500 and have collected and utilized \$20,500 since then.


Our beautiful, historic building has been around since the 1940s! It requires many repairs to keep everything maintained.

Our Recovery Drop-in Center has facilitated over 1,000 peer-led group sessions.

\$6 funds a snack bag for a hungry person in our community. \$40 covers the cost of books and materials for a member of a discipleship group. \$400 funds an entire holiday party for neighborhood kids.
